

## RoHS MATERIAL COMPOSITION DECLARATION

The RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC & 2011/65/EU restricts the use of hazardous substances used in electrical and electronic equipment. It states that:

Confirmation of compliance status by our suppliers is either because the products do not contain any of the restricted substances referred to in Article 4 (l) of the RoHS Directive or because removal of the restricted substances is not technically possible and their existence in the products at levels in excess of these concentrations is allowed as one of the particular applications listed in the Annex to the RoHS Directive.

For these purposes, the maximum concentration of the restricted substances by weight in homogeneous materials are :

1) Lead	0.1%
2) Mercury	0.1%
3) Hexavalent Chromium	0.1%
4) Polybrominated Biphenyls	0.1%
5) Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers	0.1%
6) Cadmium	0.01%
7) Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
8) Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
9) Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
10) Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

Amendment in the existing EU RoHS 2 directive (2011/65/EU) On March 31<sup>st</sup> 2015. Addition of new four substances as per RoHS 3 (2015/863/EU) in force June 4, 2015.

We hereby confirm that the capacitors supplied do not contain the above RoHS restricted substances.
